



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF BUILDING BLOCK MANUFACTURING COMPANY.

We, the undersigned, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the provisions of chapter II, of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1873, and the acts of the legislature of said state amendatory thereof, and supplementary thereto, and to that end have adopted and do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I. The name of this corporation shall be Building Block Manufacturing Company. The general nature of the business of this corporation shall be and be limited to the manufacture of hollow concrete building blocks and machinery and appliances for manufacturing the same and business essential thereto, and the sale of articles manufactured by it either under letters patent or otherwise.

ARTICLE II. This corporation shall commence business on the 30th day of January, A. D. 1904, and shall continue for a period of ten years.

ARTICLE III. The capital stock of this corporation shall be one million dollars, which shall be paid in at such times and in such manner as the board of directors of this corporation may determine.

ARTICLE IV. The highest amount of indebtedness to which this corporation shall at any time be subject shall be five hundred thousand dollars.

ARTICLE V. The names and places of residence of the persons forming this corporation are: Samuel Whaley, William F. Porten and Charles W. Buechner, each residing at St. Paul, Minnesota, and James W. Cooper, residing at Minneapolis, Minnesota.

ARTICLE VI. This corporation shall be governed by three (3) directors, who shall be stockholders of this corporation. The directors shall elect from among their number a president, vice president, secretary and treasurer, who shall hold office for one year and until their successors are elected and qualify. Any two of said officers, except president and vice president, may be held by one person.

ARTICLE VII. The capital stock of this corporation shall consist of twenty thousand shares of the par value of fifty dollars each.
