The Monday Night Dancing club had a pretty valentine party last evening in Mrs. Noble's hall and danced in a tangle of pink hearts and roses.


The women of St. Mark's Pro-Cathedral gave a pleasant birthday party last evening in the parish hall and about 200 guests were present.
