PONGEES, MOHAIRS AND LINENS IN RED



CLOTH GOWN WITH FANCY BRAIDING.

New York, March 9.—Red gowns are, as a rule, associated chiefly with winter fashions, but the color is one that is generally becoming, is to be had in so many different materials, as well as in different shades, that every season sees it in favor.
