RAILROADS. COMPANY WILL GIVE GUARANTEE

MORE SUBSIDY FOR BRITISH COLUMBIAN NORTHERN.

Agreement Between Colonial Government and Promoters of Important Line Into the Far Northwest Is Reached—Subsidy to Come Up at June Session of Legislature.

Victoria, B. C., April 11.—In reply to representatives of the British Columbian Northern and MacKenzie Valley Railway company, who asked if the British Columbian government would supplement the dominion government's subsidy to the railway by a substantial provincial subsidy, Premier McBride said that if the company would deposit a guarantee forfeit fund of \$25,000 to induce the building of the railway, the specified time his government would make the British Columbian Northern and MacKenzie Valley railway project the third of the railway measures to be dealt with at a special summer session of the legislature next June, when a suitable subsidy, in proportion to that granted by the dominion government, would be passed.

A reply has been received that it is, providing the dominion subsidy is satisfactory. The new railway will traverse the Northern British Columbia gold fields and give direct railway communication with Dawson City, as well as Fort Simpson, which is expected to become soon the great port for oriental steamers.
