Compared with the returns of Jan. 22, it shows that the total resources increased from \$12,942,816 to \$12,803,123. Cash reserve decreased from \$919,987 to \$836,531. Individual deposits increased from \$12,638,830 to \$13,050,543. The average reserve held fell from 22.47 to 15.63 per cent. —W. W. Jermans.
