EMPLOYEES RESENT CERTAIN FEATURES OF HILL REGIME.

Trouble is brewing for the Burlington railroad system because of the introduction of "Jim Hill" methods in transportation, and a radical adjustment of the wage schedule for employees on runs, or a strike which will tie up the system appear to be the alternative ways of solving the problem.

Within the past two weeks two important meetings of Burlington employees have been held for the purpose of arranging a plan of defense. The first of these was in the form of local gatherings all along the system. The second was held in Chicago last Sunday and was attended by delegates from the local unions of the various brotherhoods into which the trainmen, engineers, firemen, conductors and messengers are organized.

CHARTER VOTE AT PRIMARIES

COMMISSION'S PLAN TO INSURE INTELLIGENT BALLOT.

They Have Canvassed the Situation Carefully and Believe that, by Announcing a Special Election on Primary Day, Action Would Be Legal.

The charter commission proposes that the new charter be voted on at the primary election instead of at the general election, believing that in the excitement of the national, state, county, legislative and school board elections, the voters will be likely to overlook the charter.

The lawyers on the charter commission have discussed this question and have concluded that the council can designate any day for the submission of the charter. It is in order to save the expense of polling places and election officials, the commission suggests to the council the advisability of holding a primary and special charter election.

CANDIDATE SAYS PEOPLE ARE INTERESTED IN THE FIGHT.
