WASHBURN LINE SOLD

TRANSFER WAS MADE LAST NIGHT—SOO ROAD NOW IN POSSESSION AND OPERATING TRAINS.

Bismarck, N. D., May 16.—The transfer of the Bismarck, Washburn & Great Falls road to the Soo line was made at midnight Sunday, and the Washburn trains were run over the Soo tracks this morning. A large crowd was at the Soo station, witnessing the inauguration of the new management.

The Washburn general offices here have been abolished. A few men will remain until all the delays of the transfer are closed.

A reduction from 4 to 3 cents a mile for passenger rates was announced to-day on the new branch. The Washburn train crews have been taken into the Soo service.

THE BREAD AND BUTTER STATE

FINE AGRICULTURAL SHOWING AT ST. LOUIS.

Minnesota's Exhibit in the Palace of Agriculture is Notable for Its Beautiful and Practical Features—The Horticultural Exhibit, Too, is Striking and Attractive.

St. Louis, May 16.—That department of the exposition in which the northern states are most conspicuous for the value and merit of their exhibits is the section devoted to the great agricultural interests. The Palace of Agriculture is the largest of all the buildings, being 1,600 feet long and 500 feet wide, and covering an area of over twenty acres—the largest building ever constructed to house a single class of exhibits. It contains almost every known agricultural product and every imaginable appliance for the farmer's use. Beside the raw products, there is to be a collective exhibit showing the hundreds of articles made from them and in many instances the process of manufacture actually carried on. For instance, in addition to specimens of corn, one may see it made into many of its numerous by-products, from meal, starch and breakfast foods down to cob pipes. And so with many of the other staple products, such as wheat, cotton, tobacco, etc.

In her exhibit, Minnesota has assumed her well-known name, "The Bread and Butter State," and, appropriately, grain and dairy products form the chief attractions of the exhibit. The booth is in section 50 of the Agricultural Palace; the entrance, facing the south, is in the form of a Roman archway, covered with a high grade of yellow corn; across the top in red letters is the inscription:

MINNESOTA, THE BREAD AND BUTTER STATE.
