WHETHER THE PARK BAND IS MADE PERMANENT.

Mr. Oberholfer's Programs Will Include Late, Catchy Pieces Sure to Prove Popular with the Masses—Concerts to Begin Next Monday Evening.

Whether the Minneapolis Park band shall become a permanent organization and help to swell the glory and prestige of the city or not, depends very much upon the reception accorded Mr. Oberholfer and his men during the coming concert season at Lake Harriet.

When it was ascertained that the street railway company would not rebuild the pavilion, a committee from the Minneapolis Retail Dealers' association waited on the park board and urged that other steps be taken for the erection of a pavilion, and that the entertainments be continued for the benefit of the citizens of Minneapolis and her visitors.

When the matter first took form, it was earnestly desired by the board that the local musicians, of whom the city had a large number of more than usual excellence, should be given the first opportunity in the matter of an engagement.

Mr. Oberholfer's catholicity of spirit, musically speaking, will add materially to the pleasure of the Harriet concert, for he has arranged to present much of the better class of popular music, which has had so much vogue of late.
