RAILROADS.

GRAIN RATES REDUCED. ATLANTIC COAST LINE RAILROADS AGREE UPON NEW SCHEDULE, WHICH WILL EQUALIZE CANADIAN RATES.

New York, June 30.—A reduction in east-bound grain rates has been agreed upon by the Atlantic coast line railroads.

Under the new tariff all grain from Buffalo is placed upon a 3-cent basis. This is a reduction of one bushel on wheat and flax, three-fourths cent a bushel on corn and half a cent a bushel on barley.

A 3-cent rate on wheat means that grain can be brought from Chicago to Buffalo at a cost of 10 cents a bushel and placed alongside ship for export charges of seven-eighths cent a bushel net, can be placed on board ship for 5 1/2 cents.
