RAWLINGS PLAYS INSANITY DODGE

CONFLICTING STORIES OF THE SHOOTING OF MORRISON.

Blood Money, He Says, Was Never Paid Over—His Latest Story Is That He Learned All the Details of the Crime from the Men Who Really Committed It.

Red Lodge, Mont., Aug. 5.—Roy Rawlings, who was arrested here for shooting Lincoln J. Morrison, a prominent attorney, several different stories of the crime. It is believed he is trying to create the impression that he is insane.

Upon the arrival of the undersheriff, Felix Alston, of Big Horn county, who, with other officers, visited Rawlings in his cell, the latter again confessed to participating in the Wyoming crime. He tells how he and three others shot Morrison from the brush, stating that night at the ranch of a cattleman who hired him to do the deed, and then leaving in the morning on horses furnished by the ranch.

But this afternoon Rawlings contradicted this story, in which he had even detailed the woman's appearance and described his family and brand. His latest declaration is that he learned all the details of the crime, including the selling for four men he met at Bridger, who gave him \$800 in cash to say he committed it.
