MILLER REPLIES TO McCLEARY

OPEN LETTER FROM LUVERNE CONGRESSIONAL CANDIDATE. Repels the Charge that He is Out of Step with Party Men on the Question of Tariff Revision and Reiterates Adherence to the General Declarations of the National Platform.

Dear Sir: I have read in The Minneapolis Journal of Aug. 10 your reply to my announcement as a republican candidate for member of congress in this district. The personal attack in your letter is without comment. In addition to these, however, you therein impugn my republicanism and charge me with giving aid and comfort to opponents of industrial protection to American industries.

Protection which guards and develops our industries, policy is a cardinal principle of the republican party. The measure of protection should always at least equal the difference in the cost of production at home and abroad.

Left to the People. You must have overlooked the important fact that the platform fixes what the measure of protection should be "at least." But does not define what it should be "at most."

Rates to Fit Conditions. With reference to the first of these questions I made this statement in my announcement: First—I stand squarely upon the platform adopted by the last republican national convention.

Tariff on Lumber. I further stated that I favored the removal of the tariff on lumber and a reduction of present duties on certain commodities sold for export to the markets they are protected against for less than they are sold for in the home market.

On the Aggressive. In order, therefore, that the voters may be able to determine for themselves which of us, as you express it, is most "in harmony with the national platform," I ask you to answer publicly the following questions.

First—Would you favor a tariff built on the line of the difference between our cost here and abroad? Second—Do you believe that the fifty-ninth congress should take up the question of tariff revision? Third—When the tariff is revised, do you believe that the revision should be on an ascending instead of a descending scale?
