In 1895 the public service corporations paid in personal taxes not quite 1 per cent of the gross taxes of the city of Minneapolis. In 1904 they pay similarly 4 per cent.

The net bonded indebtedness of Minneapolis has increased in ten years approximately \$1,000,000. In 1895, and approximately \$7,500,000 in 1904. Of the 6.05 mills increase in rate between 1895 and 1904 2 1/2 mills

expanded locally, and its powers should be limited to equalization of the state tax returns only.

Mr. Harris suggested as remedies: First—Repeal of the act of 1897. Second—Limitation of the authority of the board to state revenues only.

Third—Change of basis of composition of board to representation from each judicial district according to taxes paid.

Fourth—Abolishment of the board. Mr. Harris' paper was full of "meat" in support of his contentions. He showed that Hennepin county, which is practically the city of Minneapolis, has one-eighth of the population of the entire state, one-tenth of the school enrollment, and pays over one-sixth of the state taxes...
