

### SHOOTS TWICE AT WASECA GIRL

MISS RYAN, TELEPHONE OPERATOR, HAS DANGEROUS WOUND.

Her Brother-in-Law, Charles Smith, Who Was Drunk and Jealous, Would Have Killed Her Had He Not Been Overpowered by Several Witnesses to the Affair—Girl Will Recover.

Waseca, Minn., Nov. 28.—Miss Alice Ryan, night operator at the telephone exchange here, was shot last evening by Charles Smith, her brother-in-law, it is believed she will recover. Smith, who is a brakeman on the North-Western road, entered the telephone office quiet this evening, and while sitting at the switchboard, and near her were Dr. Cummings, J. E. Madden, manager of the telephone company, and Harry Meyer. Miss Ryan, who was conversing with the three, asked Mr. Smith what he wanted. The latter cried: "I want you," and pulling a revolver from his pocket, quickly fired.

The shot went wild. Before the frightened people if the room could interfere Smith again fired, but this time striking Miss Ryan in the back of the neck.

As the enraged man was about to fire the third time he was overpowered.

"Charles, I did not think this of you," was the victim's only exclamation.

Smith is said to be under the influence of liquor at the time. On his way to jail he showed no remorse. He declared he would have shot the person who prevented him from shooting the third time. No motive except a jealous rage is known.

He apparently did not get back to Pine Lake.

He is described as a short, heavy man, with black mustache, speaking a decided German accent.

#### SCHERCLIFFE HAS AN ALIBI

##### DIAMOND ROBBER SURRENDERS TO DES MOINES OFFICER.

Can Show, He Says, He Was Not in Omaha When the House of Thomas Was Dynamited—Charges All His Trouble to Dennison, the "Policy King," and Says He Will Be Released.

Des Moines, Iowa, Nov. 28.—When Frank Schercliffe read in the newspapers that Chief Donahue of Omaha was accusing him of having blown up the Thomas estate, he was quick to get a statement from the police.

"Fortunately, all of my time since the day before the dynamite was thrown was spent with my relatives and so many other persons that there can be absolutely no doubt about being able to prove an alibi."

"From Marshalltown I went to Melbourne, a station on the Great Western, where I ate Thanksgiving Day dinner. I remained there until I noticed in the newspapers Saturday evening that I was being sought by the Omaha police."

Chief Hardin of Des Moines wired Chief Donahue that Schercliffe was here, but as no orders have been received to hold him the man has been set at liberty.

"This is the most cowardly attempt that Dennison and his gang have made to get rid of me. I can see now that if I didn't have my alibi I would be a goner if they ever got me back in Omaha. I have said repeatedly that I would help the authorities to bring Tom Dennison to justice. I will do it if it costs me my life. Dennison wants me out of the way before he is finally disgraced and sent to the penitentiary. He pretends not to be afraid of the evidence of a jailbird, but I'll make him cringe."

Schercliffe is quoted in the local papers this afternoon as saying that he believes Dennison or members of his gang threw the bomb at the Thomas home.

"I've got men at work on the deal, too," he said. "And hope soon to be able to claim that \$8,000 reward."

Many people here believe that Schercliffe's hatred for Dennison amounts to insanity. The ex-convict's own statement is that he will get even with Dennison in some way, and that his friends laugh at Schercliffe's threats and say that the man ought to be in an asylum.
