## CITY NEWS FINAL FIGURES ON MINNESOTA'S VOTE

ROOSEVELT CARRIED THE STATE  
BY 161,464 PLURALITY.

Of the Minnesota Congressmen, Andrew  
J. Volstead, Republican, in the Sev-  
enth District, Led All the Rest with  
a Vote of 27,080 to 341 for His Rival.

Minnesota's presidential vote:  
Roosevelt (rep.), 216,651.  
Parker (dem.), 55,187.  
Watson (pop.), 2,103.  
Swallow (pro.), 6,262.  
Debs (pub.-own.), 11,692.  
Corcoran (soc.-lab.), 974.  
Roosevelt's plurality, 161,464.  
Roosevelt's majority, 140,442.  
Total vote for president, 292,860.  
Total vote 1900, 318,311.

The official canvass of Minnesota's  
vote on president shows a larger Roose-  
velt plurality than at first figured.  
While the total vote was about 29,000  
less than four years ago, Roosevelt re-  
ceived over 26,000 votes more than Mc-  
Kinley, and Parker about 37,000 less  
than Bryan, the Parker vote being less  
than half that cast for Bryan.  
Roosevelt received over 73 per cent  
of the total vote, while four years ago  
McKinley received just 60 per cent.  
The congressional vote by districts  
can be canvassed by the state can-  
vassing board. It stands as follows:

### Official Vote on Governor.

John A. Johnson's official plurality  
over R. C. Dunn is 7,892. The official  
footings were made this afternoon by  
the state canvassing board. They give  
Dunn 140,130 votes and Johnson 147,

cers were not finished until a late hour.

### WON'T SHORTEN SKIRT

SCHOOL PRINCIPAL WHO DOESN'T  
LIKE OILED FLOORS DECLINES  
PROSPECTIVE ADVICE.

Oiled floors are gaining in favor  
among the public school teachers and  
principals. At the opening of the pres-  
ent school year, only four principals out  
of the sixty in the city were willing to  
approve the system of oiling floors and  
now more than one-half are converts to  
the oil idea.

W. H. Adams, superintendent of  
buildings, has recently obtained the  
opinions of nearly all the principals,  
and finds that at least thirty of them are  
in favor of oiling as a measure of clean-  
liness. It seems to be generally con-  
ceded that the oil catches and retains the  
dust of the schoolroom, and that the air  
is cleaner on that account, and this  
consideration is a paramount one in the  
opinion of most of the principals who  
favor it.

About twenty-eight principals appear  
more or less opposed to the use of oil,  
but of these, twelve or thirteen favor  
the use of oil on the hallways and  
stairs, but not in the schoolrooms, leav-  
ing only about fifteen who object to  
having it anywhere.

The big objection and the only one  
raised in a majority of the schools is  
that the oil in the floors is taken up  
by the dress skirts, ruining the garments.  
The answer to this objection in Boston  
was that the teachers should wear short  
skirts and anticipating such advice here  
one principal rather defiantly announces  
"My skirts are as short as I can wear  
them—three inches from the floor."  
One principal complains about injury to  
her shoes, another that the oiled floors  
are slippery, another that the oil smells  
badly and must hence be unsanitary.  
Several say that the oiled floors are  
black and dirty, and urge good old-fash-  
ioned scrubbing once a week.

dy was not forgotten and three manu-  
facturers have given notice that they  
may be called upon. A further sent  
two dozen collarettes for little girls.

None of the presents was solicited  
by the society, but all were given  
freely by the charitably inclined, who  
simply asked the Humane society to  
act as agents in seeking out the worthy  
poor.

### LIVED HERE FIFTY YEARS

Death Comes to John Walsh in His  
Eightieth Year.

John Walsh, who has been a resident  
of Minneapolis since 1855, died at his  
residence, 511 University avenue NE,  
last night at the age of 79 years. He  
is survived by his wife and eleven  
children. The children are Mary, Nel-  
lie, Agnes and John P. Walsh, all of  
Minneapolis, and George E. P. H. T.  
Walsh, all of Republic, Wash.  
The funeral arrangements have not  
yet been made. By request of Mr.  
Walsh, friends will not send floral of-  
ferings.
