WOMAN IS RAISED AS IF FROM DEAD

Strange Restoration to Life While Being Measured for Her Coffin.

New York Sun Special Service. London, Jan. 18.—"I only remember kissing my husband and feeling I was getting colder and colder. Everything else from blank to me memory until I knew I was being carried down stairs. Then I fainted again."

Alexander of Pembina Joins Teaching Force of Valley City Normal. Valley City, N. D., Jan. 18.—Owing to the large increase of attendance at the state normal school for the winter term, the management has found it necessary to secure an additional instructor. Professor W. J. Alexander, for four years county superintendent of Pembina county, began his work this week. The normal school is a four-year institution, and the law which authorizes the county superintendents to convene a board of directors once each year is for the welfare of the schools. This is conceded by educators who know the results to be one of the most valuable school laws on the statute books.
