OLD-TIME CONSERVATIVE AS REFORM LIBERAL.

Copenhagen Dissatisfied with Lack of Representation—Ingenious Swedish Inventor Devises New Process of Wood Distillation—Other Scandinavian News.

The announcement of the new Danish ministry caused several surprises. The greatest, however, was the appearance of the name of Count Rosen-levetzan, an old-time conservative, as a reform liberal.

Another surprise was the absence of H. Hage, who had demanded the finance and transportation portfolios, which demands were denied. Another explanation is that Hage refused to serve with the other members selected by Mr. Christensen.

SWEDISH INVENTOR SCORES

Treats Wood with Superheated Steam Extracting Turpentine and Tar. Frans Eilstrom, an engineer at Umea, Sweden, has obtained a patent on a method to distill wood with superheated steam, producing charcoal, turpentine and tar.

The method is cheap, the charcoal consumption small, the burning time short, and the process is simple and all the charcoal, oils and turpentine will be saved and utilized. Nothing is lost. Concerning the turpentine, it is said that it will be pure and without the burnt smell and may be favorably compared with the French turpentine.

How Cities Have Grown.

According to the census of Dec. 31, 1904, the larger cities of Sweden have increased in population during the past year. Malmö is larger by 3,357 souls, Gothenburg by 2,513, and Norrköping by 1,120. The population of some of the principal cities outside of the metropolis are as follows: Gothenburg, 126,812; Malmö, 70,332; Norrköping, 44,341; Gälle, 30,662; Helsingborg, 27,175; Karlskrona, 26,016; Örebro, 25,000; Jönköping, 23,227; Uppsala, 23,517; Lund, 18,277; Borås, 17,795; Halmstad, 16,664; Sundsvall, 15,821; Linköping, 15,397; Landskrona, 15,244.

HAWLEY GETS ANOTHER

HE FIXES THE KANSAS CITY SOUTHERN SO THAT 'IT CAN'T GET AWAY.' New York Jan. 28.—The Wall Street Journal says today: "There is apparently good authority for the statement that Edwin Hawley has purchased sufficient stock of Kansas City Southern to elect a majority of the board of directors after the termination of the voting trust April 1. 'Mr. Hawley refuses to divulge plans in regard to the property or to discuss the alleged passage of control further than to state that 'control is so held that it cannot get away. 'There is some reason to believe that in purchasing control Mr. Hawley acted as a broker merely, and that the transaction is in the interest of another southwestern road.'"
