INDIANS AT STANDING ROCK SET ALL DOUBTS AT REST.

Mother of Harrington, Who Perished by His Own Hand in the Custer Massacre, Has Search Made for His Watch and Charm—Old Warriors Are Fast Being Gathered to Their Fathers.

Special to The Journal. Fort Yates, N. D., Feb. 25.—It is about time for some alleged survivor of the Custer massacre on the Little Bighorn in 1876 to turn up in some eastern city with stories of his escape.

Lieutenant Harrington was pursued by the Indians for miles until all but two had given up the chase. Just as they had also about decided to give up, they saw a puff of smoke and Harrington fell from his horse, dying by his own hand rather than to fall into the clutches of the Indians.

A story current is that Rala-up-the-Face killed Custer, "Old Hat," as he is familiarly called, is still living here, but has used crutches many years. He did not kill Custer. None of the Indians know who killed "Long Hair," as they call him. He fell in the general massacre.


THREE IN HIDING


