NURSE WAS COOL IN THE CRISIS

MISS ANNA OLSON HEROINE OF MATERNITY HOSPITAL FIERE.

Turned in Alarm and Then Started Work of Rescuing Mothers and Their Babies—Assisted in the Work by Mrs. Mary Burnett, Matron of the Institution.

By the heroic work and coolness of Miss Anna Olson, eight nurses at the Maternity hospital, 2201 Western avenue, and of Mrs. Mary I. Burnett, matron of the institution, forty inmates, fourteen of whom were babies, were carried from the place during a fire shortly after 3 o'clock yesterday morning. The flames were well under way when discovered, but every inmate was taken from the building before the roof fell in.

The fire was discovered by Miss Olson. She turned in an alarm and awakened Mrs. Burnett and the other nurses. They made their way to the nursery and the fourteen infants, ranging in age from one day to two months, were bundled up and carried to houses near by. Then the women, some of whom were still bedfast, were carried to places of safety.

After the patients had been rescued Mrs. Burnett made a tour of the rooms and felt in every bed to see that no one had been forgotten. The roof fell in just as she emerged from the building, and had she delayed her departure an instant she would have been caught by the falling debris.

When the firemen arrived women, thinly clad, were rushing frantically about, searching for their babies and it was not until those attracted by the fire took charge of them and forced them to stay within doors, that they were quieted.

The fire was extinguished after the roof and upper part of the building had been badly damaged. The loss is estimated at \$2,000, partly on building, but largely on contents. There is \$3,200 insurance on the building, but the loss on the furnishings will be total as no insurance is carried on them. Maternity hospital was established by several Minneapolis matrons in 1887, and was in charge of Dr. Martha G. Ripley. The management will need help to restore the institution to its former condition and the friends of this worthy enterprise have a chance now to extend the helping hand with something in it at a time when it will be much appreciated. The inmates of the hospital are doing well today, and there is no indication that serious results will follow the excitement and exposure.

TROUBLE IS BREWING

Saintly City Minister Says Things Regarding Municipal Canker Sores.

Rev. Dr. John Mayhew Fulton of Central Presbyterian Church, St. Paul, from his pulpit yesterday afternoon denounced the city administration of that hamlet and demanded reform. He gave a list of gambling resorts now running full blast and petitioned the authorities to stop all gambling forthwith. The speaker compared St. Paul with Minneapolis under Mayor Jones, and, after complimenting this city, expressed the wish that St. Paul might borrow Mayor Jones.

He said that, by expressing this wish, he did not mean any disrespect to Mayor Smith, for the St. Paul executive "has gray hair and gray hair must be respected." He said the mayor meant well, but was only a figurehead. "But R. T. O'Connor is no figurehead!" he declared. "He's the whole thing and carries St. Paul in his vest pocket."

"Laws—what does he care for laws and ordinances? Nothing! He's the whole board of police commissioners, and what he says goes!"

In conclusion Dr. Fulton said: "Furthermore, it might be well for the chief to order his men on the 'beat' not to become steers for the game. It does not look well for policemen to tell where games may be found, and that there is no danger of players being 'pinched.'"

In addition, it might be well for Attorney Kane not to be quite so strenuous in refusing to issue warrants for gamblers when he is requested to do so by gamblers who have quarreled—then is the time just men should get their dues.

"Hear it, mayor, police commissioners, chief of police, grand jury and proprietors of Ryan, Clarendon, Grand Central, Acme and Savoy, we petition you to stop the gambling of this city forthwith!"

IN BARBARIC SPLENDOR

Gorgeous Circus Parade Will Outline Grandeur of a Pullman Sleeper.

Dr. Cooke, ringmaster of the university circus of March 10 and 11, has completed his program for the big show, and the list of attractions in the main tent will keep three rings going for nearly three hours. Many prominent people have already signified their intention of attending the show, among whom are William Jennings Bryan, Governor J. A. Johnson, ex-Governor Van Sant and President Cyrus Northrup.

Manager Ruble is preparing for the accommodation of an immense crowd, and will have seats for 3,000 people at each of the three performances. These will be arranged in circus style, and will contain both reserved and general admission sections. The show in the main tent will be inaugurated with a parade of regal splendor, headed by the university band, the directors of the circus following in automobiles. After the main show in the big tent a regular circus concert will be given for which a small extra charge will be made. Here will be seen the sweet singers of the university, the buck and wing dancers, acrobatic musicians, boxers, wrestlers, negro quartets and the stars of the University Glee and Mandolin clubs.
