LEGISLATURE

ADMIT THE LAW WAS VIOLATED

DUNN DEFENDERS OWN TO TRUTH OF REPORTS.

Content Only that the State Lost Nothing by the Settlements Made—Attempt to Secure Such an Admission from Johnson Fails—Accountants Promise Counter Charges Against Johnson.

The house public accounts committee resumed its sessions yesterday afternoon with S. T. Johnson, former public examiner. The hearing was not finished, and will be resumed Thursday when Mr. Johnson returns from a short trip.

The two expert accountants in the service of the committee have been examining the head accounts of the committee, and promise to present some facts for Mr. Johnson to explain in connection with his administration.

At the outset, State Auditor Iverson made a statement in reference to the bill to legalize extensions of certain timber permits during his administration.

At the hearing yesterday R. H. Jefferson asked what had been done by the experts. He inquired whether they had found any irregularities.

Swan Molander said they had demanded a rescale of the surveyor general, but none was made.

R. H. Jefferson declared the committee was wasting time in listening to surmises. It should stick to the record.

A NEW INSURANCE BILL IS AIMED AT THE ALLEGED DISCRIMINATIONS AGAINST THE NON-UNION COMPANIES.

The special insurance rate investigating committee of the house last evening agreed upon the terms of a new insurance bill which was introduced by the committee this morning.

RAISE PRIVATE CAR TAX

BACHEE BILL WOULD IMPOSE 4 PER CENT GROSS EARNINGS TAX ON FREIGHT LINES—HOUSE BUSINESS YESTERDAY.

Elias Bachee of Madison introduced a bill yesterday afternoon in the house imposing a 4 per cent gross earnings tax on private-car companies.

Walter T. Lemon presented a bill making local improvement assessments a paramount lien on property in cities over \$10,000, coming in ahead of other taxes.

John Zech introduced a bill allowing the board of control to use 50 per cent of the net profits of the state prison in any year for establishing a farm-machinery plant.

Lawrence T. Johnson introduced a bill providing a method for the transfer of townships from one county to another.

On the calendar yesterday afternoon the house passed the bill of the public lands committee, making new rules for the sale of state lands.

The Hennepin house delegation met this morning. Representative John Lund took the lead in the meeting.
