OLD MINER IS MISSING

Berns Is Thought to Have Fallen from a High Cliff.

Butte, Mont., March 29.—News has reached this city of the disappearance of Gearhart Berns, a placer miner of Seesech meadows in the Thunder Mountain district. He is supposed to have left his home several days before his absence was noticed. His neighbors became alarmed when his nearly starved cat crawled to one of their cabins, and upon investigation

it was found Berns had left his home, taking his skis with him.

Some time ago he remarked that he was going to fix the headgate to his flume in order to prepare for work on his placer ground. The flume is far up on the mountainside, where the snow is very deep, and it is believed he fell over the cliff and was killed. It has been snowing for several days steadily and the chances of finding his body are remote.

Berns was nearly 70 and almost a hermit. He had lived at Seesech meadows more than thirty years and owned valuable placer mining ground.

Samuel Olive, a miner in the Ana-

conda mine, stepped on a loose piece of timber and fell about one hundred feet, bounding from timber to timber in his descent, breaking his neck, legs and arms.

NO HOPE FOR ROONEY

Brutal Murderer of Harold Sweet Will Hang at Bismarck.

FARGO, N. D.—The end of the career of John Rooney, the murderer of Harold Sweet, seems to be in sight. The state supreme court has certified the record from the United States supreme court to the local court and the

sentence will soon be imposed. As soon as the motion is made Rooney will be brought from Bismarck to Fargo for sentence, and then taken back to the state penitentiary for his execution, which cannot take place until after six months have elapsed. There is now no hope for the life of the brutal murderer. In all the trials and appeals of his case Rooney has withheld the names of his pals in the crime. He still maintains that one of the other men stepped up behind and shot young Sweet while the victim and Rooney were struggling.

The commissioners in all the counties along the Red river valley will hold

meetings next week, when it is expected those that have not done so will make an appropriation to assist in the government survey of the Red river valley. Grand Forks and Walsh have taken a favorable action. Traill, Pembina, Cass and Richland are all interested, as much drainage work will be done. Some of the counties object because they understood the survey would be only ten miles back from the river, but Engineer Elliott writes that the survey will extend as far inland as co-operative drainage will be beneficial and possible.

At Denhoff a row between B. Baker, an employee of a hotel, and George Fuchs, a harness maker, resulted in Baker being shot thru the shoulder. The matter was adjusted and the shooter will escape prosecution.

Alfred Nordby of Colfax had an arm torn from the socket while being employed around a feed mill. He died the following day from the shock.

Near Harvey Conrad Tebellius, a 10-year-old youth, was thrown from a wagon in a runaway and his spine broken. Death resulted in a few minutes.

T. W. Jackman, the new state oil inspector, was banqueted here last night by employees of the Northern Pacific. Mr. Jackman was baggageman for his company here for twenty-three years. The extension of the Soo road across the northern part of the state is attracting the attention of business men. There are to be many townsites and unusual accompaniment of bank business houses.
