## CITY NEWS

### USEFULNESS IS GROWING

**CHILDREN'S HOME SOCIETY REPORTS, PRESENTED AT ANNUAL MEETING, MAKE AN EXCELLENT SHOWING.**

The annual meeting of the Children's Home society of Minnesota was held yesterday afternoon at the Jean Martin Brown home in St. Anthony Park. The reports made an excellent showing for the work. The society cared for 288 children during the year, 56 more than in the preceding year. There are now 28 children in the home. Since the organization of the society, in 1889, there have been 2,283 children cared for.

The beautiful new home of the society has been improved this year by the addition of a combination gas and electric lighting plant, the gift of Captain Joseph Martin, who presented the building to the society. The receipts of the year have been \$17,500 and there is a balance in the treasury of over \$500.

The following were elected for the ensuing three years to the board of directors: W. J. Dean, Mrs. E. A. Russell, Rev. E. C. Stone, Logan Brown and Rev. E. P. Savage of Minneapolis; Rev. C. A. Hultkrantz, General W. B. Bend and E. J. Johnson of St. Paul; A. W. Bradley of St. A. Duluth and Duluth. Judge J. O. Pierce was elected to take the place left vacant by the removal of E. W. Shurtleff.

The officers were re-elected as follows: President, Rev. R. N. Adams of Minneapolis; vice president, D. B. Noyes of St. Paul; honorary vice presidents, Cyrus Northrup of Minneapolis, John Martin of Minneapolis, A. Eltinger of St. Paul, Ward Ames and Colonel C. H. Graves of Duluth; recording secretary, Rev. E. C. Stone; treasurer, W. G. Geary of St. Paul; legal counsel, Daniel Doty of St. Paul.

### RECEIVED BIG ORDER

Minneapolis Firm Will Supply Smelter Plant to Mexican Miners.

The Greene Copper company of Cananea, Sonora, Mex., has ordered a fully equipped smelter plant from the Minneapolis Steel & Machinery company. This includes all the steel work necessary to such a plant, including a reverberatory furnace, ore bedding plant, etc. Seven hundred and fifty tons of steel will be used, at a cost of about \$90 a ton.

The management of the company feels highly complimented over the success of the comparatively young institution in drawing foreign business to the city.
