WINONA'S FIRST RETURNS

WINONA, MINN.—From the first returns from the census in Winona, it appears that the ambition of this city to show a population in excess of 20,000 will be realized. The government census in 1900 gave Winona a population of 19,714. The first returns are from J. J. Rogalla, who took the census in the third and fourth precincts of the fourth ward. He reports enumerating 2,860 persons, whereas there were only 2,783 persons enumerated in this district in 1900.

DEPOSITS OF MILLION AND HALF

Strong Financial Showing of Otter Tail County People.

FERGUS FALLS, MINN.—The fact that one crop failure no longer cripples western Minnesota is forcibly brought to mind by the bank statements that have been issued by the Otter Tail county bank. When the rust ruined the wheat last summer, every one predicted hard times. The crop here was a failure, and it is conservatively estimated that the county was deprived of \$1,000,000 by the loss of the wheat. And now come the bank statements. Otter Tail county has thirteen incorporated banks, and their statements show deposits of \$1,520,878.51. On Dec. 8, 1903, the banks had nearly \$200,000 less in deposits than today. Taxes have been paid full as in previous years.
