CLEAR, BRIGHT DAYS ARE NEEDED

EARLY BOWN GRAIN IS RANK AND SOFT. Healthy Green Has Disappeared from Many Fields in the Valley—Dry Weather Will Correct All This—Outlook Still Favorable on the Whole.

Special to The Journal. Grand Forks, N. D., June 26.—The weather for a week has been entirely too wet for the crops. It will not do to jump at the conclusion that the crops are ruined, or even that there is any material damage, as this is not true. The crops are looking well and there is no reason to suppose that they will not do well hereafter, but it would have been better had the weather been drier.

The growth of early grain is rank but soft, and there is a tendency to yellowness on many fields. This is seen even on the high lands, therefore it is not due to flooding, but to absence of sunlight and saturation. Of course, except in the few low spots, a few days' bright weather will correct this. The rains of the week did not add materially to the area of grain drowned by flooding. Spots north of Fargo and in the neighborhood of Crookston exist about all that have suffered in this way; elsewhere the soil has taken care of the water as it fell.

The first hailstorm of any importance occurred in the James river valley. Crops in the vicinity of Carrington are reported to be badly damaged and insurance companies are being notified. A total loss is claimed in some cases, but this is believed to be an exaggeration. The cool weather has retarded the growth of late grain and some fields of flax have an unhealthy appearance. There has been some talk of rust, but so far there is no report of its appearance. The talk seems to be the result of a nervous fear that because we had rust last year we are likely to have it this year. It is believed that rust is some rust every year, and there is always ample opportunity for plenty of it if the conditions of the growing plant are favorable for its propagation. There appears to be plenty of spores in all years. Conditions of the past week have tended to produce a plant which would afford a good place for rust spores to develop.

Fergus Falls, Minn., June 26.—The crop outlook in this locality is generally favorable, notwithstanding the continued rains. The grain is well rooted, moderately thick, and has been growing rapidly. At the same time the growth is not so rapid as in the past year, as the weather has been wet and cool rather than damp and sultry. Some fields are weedy from their neglect. In the spring, but the weeds are not troubling the farmers to any great extent, as they feel that they can get a good crop regardless of the weather. If the weather is favorable when the grain is maturing, everyone fears rust, but this is simply because of the destruction of the grain last year and the fact that there are any really dangerous indications at the present time. There is also some fear that the grain will be smothered by the weeds, but this is a fallacy, as the weeds are raised from shrubs, and their growth is not sufficient vitality to head out into full plump heads; but the general opinion, from present indications, is that it will be all right. Corn gives little promise.

Huron, S. D., June 26.—The total precipitation for the month is almost four inches. Reports concerning crops are of the very best; from every direction come statements of phenomenal growth of wheat and other small grain. All stand unusually heavy on the ground, and rye, barley and oats are fast maturing in many fields. The abundant moisture and heavy growth of head gives rise to fears that, should wind occur, much grain would lodge. Farmers are already preparing for harvest by cutting up their machinery; there is likely to be, as in former years, a scarcity of reliable help. Corn, in spite of the wet and cool weather, is making fine progress, and is generally speaking, fields are free from weeds. An enormous hay crop is assured, and so far as millet and other grasses are concerned, the conditions are specially favorable.

President Orders Exempt Classes of Celestials Accorded Fair Treatment.

Washington, June 26.—By direction of President Roosevelt, action has been taken by the administration, which not only will facilitate the landing in this country of Chinese of the exempt classes, but will also eliminate from the immigration bureau such administrative features as have been the subject of criticism by Chinese. It is the declared intention of the president to see that Chinese merchants, travelers, students and others of the exempt classes shall have the same courtesy shown to them by officers of the immigration bureau as is accorded to citizens of the most favored nation.

Results of Complaints. Representations have been made to the president that in view of alleged harsh treatment accorded to many Chinese seeking a landing in the United States, the commercial guilds of China have determined to institute a boycott on American manufacturers. The representations, backed by the authority of the American Asiatic society and commercial bodies throughout the country, induced the president to make an investigation of the situation, with a view of removing the cause of complaint, if they were found to exist. The subject was discussed thoroughly by the cabinet and the president took it up personally with Secretary Metcalf of the department of commerce and industry, who has supervision of the immigration bureau.

Certificates Are Good. As a result of the inquiry, orders have been issued to the diplomatic and consular representatives of the United States in China by the president himself that they must look closely to the performance of their duties under the exclusion law and to the members of the exempt class coming to this country are provided with proper certificates. These certificates will be accepted at any port of the United States and will guarantee the bearer against any harsh or discourteous treatment. Such treatment, indeed, will be the cause of the instant dismissal of the offending official, whoever he may be.

May Pacify China. In addition to the president's orders, Secretary Metcalf has issued instructions to the immigration officers, which, it is believed, will remove the heretofore complained of by the Chinese government and individuals. It is expected that the prompt action taken by the government to meet the objections made by the Chinese will eliminate the possibility of serious trade difficulties between China and the manufacturers of this country.

GOOD ROAD MEN ORGANIZE PERMANENT ASSOCIATION EFFECTED AT THE CONVENTION HELD AT LINDSTROM.

Lindstrom, Minn., June 26.—The good roads convention here on Saturday was a success, more because of the excellent character of the sessions than because of the attendance, threatening weather serving to keep many away. J. T. Elwell, chairman of the executive committee of the state association, spoke on "Practical Good Road Building" from a farmer's standpoint, and offered some very practical hints. He urged the building of straight roads, and the following of section lines. He advocated that prisoners at Stillwater be employed at Taylors Falls in breaking up trap rock for the roads. He said that there is enough trap rock in that place to cover the roads of Minnesota and Iowa. There should be, he said, a county engineer, who should be salaried, his entire time to be given to the planning and directing of road building. After a general discussion of the subject, a permanent good roads organization was effected. Officers were elected and a constitution adopted. C. Andrews, Lindstrom, was elected president; E. Johnson, Lindstrom, secretary; E. Nordgren, Sunrise, Minn., treasurer. Each district or town will have a vice president. The prospects are good for road improvement.

Among other speakers were A. N. Johnson of the United States department of agriculture; Congressman F. C. Stevens, Gust Shalley and George W. Hazzard.
