KEEPING CLOSE WATCH OF CROPS

REPORTS REGARDING THE RUST ARE MORE REASSURING.

Some Smut in South Dakota and Black Rust in Patches but It Seems to Be More on the Leaf Than on the Stem and Is Not Spreading at Present—The Canadian Crop Is Large.

Special to The Journal. Winona, Minn., July 25.—The reports from along the lines of the Chicago and Northwestern road west of Winona to the effect that the stories of black rust damage to crops are not so alarming as they were some time ago, are being given out today by H. C. Garvin, manager of the Bay State Milling company of this city. Mr. Garvin says:

"From an expert who is traveling thru the territory by train we are getting semi-daily reports. On Monday the state was reduced to a very small area where the black rust was said to exist. He found no trace of black rust on the stalks. There was a little on the leaves, but no damage had been done to the wheat so far. The yield in this section will be from twelve to fifteen bushels, an increase in acreage over last year of five to ten per cent. The result of this crop will be known by Saturday, when wheat in this territory will be being damaged."

Clay County Corn Is Good.

Special to The Journal. Vermillion, S. D., July 25.—The past ten days have done wonders for corn. The stalks have shot upwards at a rapid pace and are looking better on the upland and that on the bottom, which was materially retarded by too much moisture, is now looking fine and will come out all right. A good rain would now be appreciated. The small grain harvest is well under way. A number of farmers will be cutting oats this week. A few have already started.

BLUE EARTH, MINN.—The reports of black rust in the wheat in the southern part of the county are not well founded. Occasional stalks of the bearded variety are found and seen to be badly affected, but there is little of it mixed with the other that no appreciable damage is done.
