HEAVY ARRIVALS OF PRODUCE LINES

BUTTER AND EGGS RULE LOWER IN CONSEQUENCE

Cheese is Firm on Well-Cured Goods—Poultry and Veal Fairly Firm—Fruit Movement Restricted but Slightly by the Railroad Strike—Lemons Are Higher, Hot Weather Increasing the Demand—Watermelons Lower.

Contrary to general expectations, the fruit market out has not been seriously interfered with this week. A good many of the smaller stations have been cut out, but the towns which are the largest buyers have been open and a larger business has been transacted than during many weeks before the trouble set in.

In butter, the excess of receipts has run to creamery extras. The supply has been somewhat excessive, but the week shows a half cent decline, and the week closes with heavy offerings in sight and no well defined immediate demand. The market is generally quiet. The fact that a good many lines coming from factories whose output usually grades extra are showing imperfections unfavorable to receivers, who of course are anxious to secure all possible quality, has had a tendency to check the market. There is a steady line of customers who want the grade of goods they are paying for. There is hardly as much activity for low grades and packing stock as formerly, but the price has been well upheld. Reports that a heavy Australian production is likely to be marketed in England from now on, cutting off the foreign demand from this country, is having somewhat of a disturbing influence on the market.
