CITY NEWS ELECTRIC STORM SHOCKS THE CITY

HEAVY DOWNPOUR ACCOMPANIED BY BLINDING LIGHTNING.

Telephone and Telegraph Communication and Street Car Traffic Temporarily Interfered With—Horse Killed by Live Wire—St. Paul Woman Knocked Unconscious While Telephoning.

Starting with a heavy downpour yesterday afternoon, which continued by sporadic showers until after midnight, Minneapolis suffered from one of the most severe electric storms in years. The rain gage at the weather bureau registered 1.62 inches, and St. Cloud reported a fall of 2.40 inches. As far north as Duluth, 1.45 inches of rain fell.

Back yards and spots of ground which were not protected by a heavy turf suffered from washouts. The sands from the sides of the streets was washed across the pavements, and in many places the streetcar service was held up until the tracks could be cleared.
