MURDER CAUSES EXCITEMENT AT MESABA MINING TOWN. William Kimlink Is Shot by Dempsey, a Bartender, at Biwabik, Who Gives No Reason for Tragedy—Police Investigate Mysterious Disappearance at Duluth.

Special to The Journal. Duluth, Minn., Oct. 30.—A shocking murder occurred at Biwabik, on the Mesaba range, shortly after 6 o'clock on Sunday when a bartender named Dempsey shot and instantly killed William Kimlink. The victim of the tragedy kept a boarding house and Dempsey was a boarder.
