MICHIGAN ENGINEER WRITES OF CANAL PROJECT

MICHIGAN MAN SEES MUCH WORK WITH SMALL RESULTS.

Declares Venture "Is Just a Big Bundle of Red Tape at Present," but Sees Possibilities of Future Improvement—Yellow Fever Is Not a Source of Danger.

Special to The Journal. Ironwood, Mich., Nov. 7.—Writing from Panama, where he is employed as a civil engineer, Louis Whiting, formerly in the service of the Goetzke rube mining companies, declares that the canal project is just a big bundle of red tape at present. He mentions several instances of complex procedure, entailing much work with small results. He says there is an army of clerks accomplishing practically nothing, and thinks the administrative feature of the big ditch proposition could stand great improvement. Mr. Whiting says that little real work is being done yet, nor can the undertaking be prosecuted intelligently until the final plans have been decided on. Settlement on the isthmus, at first strongly in favor of a sea-level canal, now inclines to the adoption of the French plan of a lock canal, ninety feet above the level of the sea. There is nothing impossible about either plan, the writer says, but the sea-level canal would take longer to build, and is the element most involved. Much of the work in hand at present consists of cutting away the jungle around the settlements, draining the swamps and "making the negroes clean."
