

HITCHCOCK ENDS WHITE EARTH ROW

Orders Allotments Completed—Order Affecting Island Lands Is Issued.

Washington, Nov. 8.—Secretary Hitchcock has closed the controversy as to the White Earth reservation by directing Agent Mischelet to complete allotments, according to the plans outlined before protests were made to the department.

Under a recent order by the secretary of the interior, no entries will hereafter be allowed for isolated and disconnected tracts of public lands containing less than forty acres, until after congress has been given an opportunity to enact further laws for their disposal.

Under the present law, these tracts, including many small islands in Minnesota and Wisconsin, which are becoming very valuable and are being eagerly sought for summer residences and resorts, must remain unopened to homestead entry for three years before they can be sold for cash to the highest bidder.

Tracts of this character are of little real value for agricultural purposes, and the manner in which title is now acquired is believed to be a perversion of the honest government which is believed that they should be permanently withdrawn from homestead entry, and sold to the highest bidder in the first instance, thus enabling government to realize their true value.

The commissioner of the general land office in accordance with the secretary's order has issued a circular to local land officers carrying the order into effect.
