Singular Menu for Banquet in Nebraska, with Wilson the Guest of Honor.

Journal Special Service. Lincoln, Neb., Nov. 28.—Corn, and corn alone, will furnish the menu for the most singular banquet ever given in the west. This feast will take place at the Lincoln hotel in this city on the evening of Dec. 15. From the time the guests partake of the corn soup until the chronic smokers gaze idly at the smoke ringlets emanating from cornhusk cigars, maize will be used for the viands. A French chef has been working on the menu for weeks, and it will be a fantastic feast. Secretary of Agriculture Wilson will be the guest of honor and the noted men of Nebraska will be invited.

The menu is given to the contestants in the Nebraska corn-growing contests. These are 500 girls and boys of the public schools who have planted corn under the direction of the state department of public instruction. Prizes will be awarded after the banquet.

Nebraska white prize hot corn bread with state farm student corn butter. Aunt Chloe's corn pone. Crisp fried hominy grits. Crisped corn supper. Reid's yellow dent Johnny cake, with milk. Baked Indian corn pudding. Cream of corn soup. Molded corn ice cream. Corn meal wafers. Golden corn cake. Corn coffee. Corn husk cigars.

NAN PATTERSON SEES A TRAGIC WELCOME

Journal Special Service. New York, Nov. 28.—Just as Nan Patterson, with her husband, Leon G. Martin, stepped ashore from the steamship Once, on their return here from San Juan, Porto Rico, yesterday, a man threw up his arms, cried out and dropped dead before her startled gaze. The utmost confusion took place, and Miss Patterson became hysterical and had to be cared for.

Russell, who was descending the gangplank. Directly behind the latter was Nan Patterson. The aged captain's fingers had just touched the outstretched hands of Lieutenant Russell when death swept down on him.

ROOT IS TO TRY TO OFFSET THE KAISER

Washington, Nov. 28.—Secretary Root's proposed visit to Brazil to attend the next conference of the Pan-American convention will be primarily to offset the influence of Germany in South and Central America. When the conference meets he will inform the delegates that this government desires to be only their consistent, unselfish and powerful friend. It will guarantee that there is no thought of aggression or exploitation in the mind of the Americans. He will remind them of the fact that the independence of the new world countries will be guaranteed from the day they are able to present a united front.

REPRIMAND FOR YOUNG

Punishment to Be Meted Out to Bennington's Commander. Journal Special Service. Washington, Nov. 28.—Captain Lucien Young, who was in command of the Bennington, was reprimanded for carelessness, which was indirectly responsible for the explosion of the boiler of the ship and the killing of a large number of the crew. Stories that he will escape with a reprimand are afloat at the navy department, but the secretary of the navy nor the judge advocate general, who has charge of the findings of the court, will not confirm them.

Webster City Business Men Seek Release of Dan Wren. WEBSTER CITY, IOWA.—The spectacle of twenty prominent citizens appearing with a federal judge in behalf of a man sentenced to the penitentiary for the killing of a man whose letters thru the mails, is a new experience that has just come to Judge Reed of Dan Wren, one of the most picturesque characters known in the history of Webster City. Serious charges against Wren were recommended by the grand jury.

FATAL FAMILY QUARREL

Milwaukee Laborer Is Shot and His Son Killed. MILWAUKEE, WIS.—In a family quarrel last night, Frank Allotta, a city laborer, was shot in the head, an infant son, named Angelo Allotta, was shot thru the body and killed, and Mrs. Frank Allotta's arm was broken. The police are investigating the shooting. Allotta, a brother of Frank, who is supposed to have done the shooting, fired six shots in all were fired.

ASKS HEAVY DAMAGES

Suit Filed Against North Dakota Bank for \$50,000. GRAND FORKS, N. D.—Henry Kurtz has brought a suit against the First National bank of Harvey and J. H. Eiler, president; August Peterson, cashier; John O. Hanchett, attorney; and J. F. McGinn, an officer who made the arrest for \$50,000 damages for false imprisonment. The case will be tried at the January term of the district court to be held at Harvey.
