**NORTHERN ITASCA TO BE SET OFF**

**COUNTY OF KOOCHICHIKING KNOCKING FOR ADMISSION.**

A Petition for an Election to Be Started at Once—International Falls Chosen as County Seat for Northern Part—Grand Rapids Will Not Oppose It.

Itasca county will vote on a proposition for division of the county this fall. The north half of the county, comprising the Rainy lake region and the section along the Minnesota & International, wants to go it alone.

C. W. Stanton of International Falls was in Minneapolis today and left this afternoon for home, where he will begin the circulation of a petition. If this petition is signed by 25 per cent of the voters of the county, it will be filed and the governor will issue a proclamation submitting it at the general election.

The county is too large and division is inevitable.
