

COLD, GOLD WAVE GRIPS THE EAST

New England and the Middle Atlantic Coast Suffer from Low Temperature.

Washington, Feb. 6.—A statement of weather conditions and general forecast issued by the weather bureau today as follows: The cold wave has reached the New England and middle Atlantic coast and cold weather is general this morning east of the Rocky mountains except in the south Atlantic states, the temperature ranging from 10 to 35 degrees below the reasonable average.

Rome, N. Y., Feb. 6.—Northern New York was today swept by a cold wave which involved greater hardships because of the unusual low in the south Atlantic states, the temperature being by far the coldest of the winter.

Saratoga, N. Y., Feb. 6.—Thirty degrees below zero was the temperature here at sunrise today, which is the coldest day of this winter.

Boston, Feb. 6.—A cold wave, driven by a high wind, sent a shiver over New England today. The coldest point was at Northfield, Vt., where the thermometer registered 22 degrees below zero.

Pittsburg Suffering. Pittsburg, Feb. 6.—With the government thermometer registering 2 degrees below zero and as low as 10 degrees below zero in different parts of the city, the weather here today experienced the coldest weather of the winter.

Superior, Wis., Feb. 6.—At 7:30 this morning the mercury stands at 25 1/2 below zero. Yesterday's record of 28 below at 8 a. m. was broken at 11 a. m., when the mercury fell to 31 below at 8 a. m.

La Crosse, Wis., Feb. 6.—The cold weather of yesterday was intensified today, the thermometer falling to 18 degrees below zero. The extreme weather is interfering with the running of trains and all are from one to three hours late today.
