MAIL CRASHES INTO FREIGHT AT HASTINGS

Special to the Journal. Hastings, Minn., Feb. 19.—A head-on collision occurred in the lower yard of the Milwaukee road and a switch engine of the Kalamazoo road, yesterday morning.

Two or three of the freight cars, loaded with grain and merchandise, were derailed and the engine and several express cars were telescoped by the tender.

It appears that the freight train was just entering from the passing track to the main line when the fast mail came around the curve and met it.
