TWO-POUND IOWA BABE THRIVES IN INCUBATOR. Iowa Falls, Iowa, April 16.—The baby incubator that attracted so much attention at the St. Louis fair is being imitated on a crude and small scale in Wright county, where Dr. Garth, of Clarion, is trying to save the life of a two-pound baby incubator.

The parents of the babe are Mr. and Mrs. J. E. Penninger. It was thought at first it could not survive, but the physician decided to try the incubator method, and he succeeded beyond his expectations.

The improvised incubator was made of two small-sized boxes and in the lower one were placed several jugs of hot water. The upper box was covered with glass and lined with cotton-batt.

The bottom of the upper box was made of canvas so as to allow the heat from the jugs to circulate thru the upper box.

The thermometer was placed in the upper box and the heat was regulated by the addition of a new jug of hot water occasionally. The baby is being upon malted milk, a few drops being given every two hours.
