REBELLION NIPPED IN BUD BY TAFT

Plotters Against Panama's President Threatened by Interference of United States.

Washington, May 10.—"Revolutionary movements or election troubles in Panama which in any way interfere with work on the canal zone, justify interference by the United States, in support of the Panama government." Such is the tenor of the instructions sent to Governor MacGoey of the canal zone by Secretary Taft, who also submitted a letter from Secretary Root of the state department, setting forth in detail a justification for American interference in case of disorder in any part of Panama. This emphatic declaration of the position of the United States, it is believed, will prevent serious trouble at the elections to be held in June. Secretary Taft makes it clear that any disorder in the republic will hinder canal work on the latter point, and is discouraging to opponents of President Amador, who are said to have been planning a movement against him, believing that the United States would not suppress any insurrection unless it extends within the zone.

LONG-LOST RECORDS MAY BARE 'YELLOW DOG' ACTS

Journal Special Service. New York, May 11.—District Attorney Jerome is in possession of a mass of records which are of the utmost importance to the special grand jury that is investigating the alleged criminal doings in the Mutual Life insurance company. The records, it is expected, will pave the way for the indictment of several men of great wealth and prominence. The discovery of the district attorney included the "lost" records of Andy Fields' supply department, which high officials of the Mutual Life have for months declared were made away with and destroyed. Frederick Cromwell, former treasurer of the company and one of the right-hand men of Richard A. McCurdy, said that the records disappeared mysteriously when the hunt for Fields began last fall, and that he was sure they would never come back. Mr. Fields, it is believed, had much to do with the district attorney's getting possession of the records. So much headway has been made by the grand jury in the last three days in getting at the inner workings of the Mutual's supply department, that the district attorney is in no hurry to examine Fields. Edgar W. Rogers, the head man in Lysander W. Lawrence's stationery store, which was practically an annex to the supply department and was used by Fields in his "yellow dog" transactions, was before the grand jury today and added another chapter to his confession, which was begun on Monday. It is now said that approximately \$100,000 a year, supposedly spent by the Mutual Life for printing and stationery and charged to that account on "yellow dog" bills, really went into the "yellow dog" fund, controlled by Fields and disbursed by him.

INVITES CROWD TO SEE HIM KILL SELF

Journal Special Service. Hartford, Conn., May 11.—"The average minister does not know how to preach a funeral service," said Andrew Fay, 22 years old, of Rockville, Conn., standing in the street. As he spoke, he opened a prayerbook, and the crowd moved closer. In one hand he held an open clasp-knife. "I'm going for a long journey, friends," he continued, smiling grimly. "I'm going to cross the Styx. To insure myself a comfortable passage, I mean to read my own funeral service." In melodramatic style, Fay read from the prayerbook. When he had reached the words, "Dust to dust, ashes to ashes," a policeman pushed thru the throng. Fay struck at him with the knife, but the policeman caught his arm and captured the weapon. Fay was in custody today awaiting examination on a charge of attempted suicide. He said he was out of work and decided to end his life.
