


WATTERSON LAUDS HIS STATE--KENTUCKY

Never More Eloquent Than in His Address at "Home Coming" Celebration.

Henry M. Watterson's wonderful oratory was never heard to better advantage than in his address of last Wednesday in the Kentucky "Home Coming" celebration at Louisville.




