Waupaca, Wis., July 10.—Rev. Myron Brigham of Chilton and Miss Alice Rasmussen of Neenah were drowned in Beasley lake yesterday by the overturning of a skiff. Both bodies were recovered.

Calumet, Mich., July 10.—George Simmons, aged 24, was drowned in Portage lake last night while bathing his horses. He was on the bank of one of them and fell off, and it is thought the horse kicked him. He was a good swimmer, but sank immediately.

La Crosse, Wis., July 10.—Assd. Munyer, son of Mr. and Mrs. S. C. Munyer, was drowned in Black river while bathing. He was 11 years of age. He stepped into a hole in the river and disappeared.

Chisholm, July 10.—While swimming in Longyear lake near here, Frank Blanchard, aged 20, was seized with cramps and drowned.
