

# WAR STARTED ON CATALOG HOUSES

30,000 Retailers Represented in a Strong New Movement in Iowa.

Des Moines, Iowa, Aug. 3.—The Iowa State Federation of Mercantile associations, representing 30,000 retailers in nearly every line of trade, wholesalers and manufacturers in this state, was organized here yesterday afternoon. It is designed to seek the welfare of retailer, jobber and manufacturer in general, and to fight the encroachments of the big mail-order houses in particular. It is the strongest move yet made to protect the retailer against the growing business of the catalog houses.

The new organization will bring pressure to bear upon all manufacturers and jobbers to secure from them an agreement not to sell their goods to the catalog houses. It will appoint a legislative committee to lobby in the interest of laws designed to benefit the interest which it represents. Some changes in the statute regarding exemption from debt are especially sought by the retail merchants.

The association was formed at a meeting of representatives from all the retail trade organizations of the state and of wholesale and jobbing interests. The officers elected were: President, John Melhopp of Council Bluffs, secretary of the Iowa and Nebraska Wholesale Grocers' association; vice president, A. C. Hutchins of Des Moines, secretary of the Iowa State Manufacturers' association; secretary-treasurer, Ira B. Thomas of Des Moines, secretary of the Iowa State Retail Merchants' association, comprising the retail grocers and butchers.

These officers are temporary, and the permanent organization is to be ratified by the several state organizations interested. These include the wholesale grocers, manufacturers, retail grocers and butchers, retail druggists, retail hardware dealers, retail implement dealers, retail furniture dealers and retail jewelers. Stepped from One Track in Front of Engine on Another.

Superior, Wis., Aug. 3.—Teles Labrie and his 13-year-old son were killed by a railroad engine near Saunders at 3:30 o'clock yesterday afternoon. They had been picking berries and were walking toward town. They stepped off one track to get out of the way of a passenger train and were struck from behind by a freight engine. Both were killed almost instantly.
