

BISMARCK HORSE THIEF IS CAUGHT

SHERIFF ARRESTS A RUSTLER AT ARBDEEN, S. D.

Team Stolen from North Dakota Ranch Is Recovered and Prisoner Confesses - Milwaukee Employee Saves Man from Being Killed by Freight Engine.

Special to The Journal. Aberdeen, S. D., Aug. 27.-A clever arrest of a horse thief was made here by Deputy Sheriff Hazel, who also recovered two horses stolen from a ranch near Bismarck and a saddle stolen from a river boat on the river at Bismarck.

Harrington disappeared from a ranch a few miles south of Bismarck, N. D., a week ago last Wednesday, taking two black horses and a saddle. Two days ago he was traced to Herd, S. D., where he was arrested by Sheriff Hazel. He disposed of the saddle in a second-hand store and was just about to close a deal for the sale of the horses when the deputy sheriff came on the scene. He at once recognized the animals by the description sent from Bismarck.
