'BOY MAYOR' FOILED BY UPSETTING AUTO

Milwaukee's Executive Defeated by Accident in Attempt to Beat Record.

Journal Special Service. New York, Sept. 5.—Sherburn M. Becker, boy mayor of Milwaukee, will not break his sixty-hour record between New York and Chicago.

When Mayor Becker made his dash from Milwaukee to New York his auto traveled the distance in sixty hours. Fired with a determination to excel the time on the return trip, he started from Fifty-fifth street and Broadway, only to come to grief near Newburg, where the automobile skidded across a slippery patch in the road and then upset, sprawling the mayor and his fellow travelers, William F. Hooker, the owner's brother-in-law; Garrison Smith of Milwaukee; H. D. Hooker, secretary to the president of the Erie railroad; Charles D. Weed, representing an automobile company, and John Webster, the chauffeur.

All hands were hurt, but not seriously, and a delay of seven hours was occasioned before a broken axle and several minor dislocations and fractures of the auto gear could be repaired. John W. Gates, a "million" with the young mayor that the time "had" would not be even equaled by the time coming. Mr. Gates wins, of course.

AUTO CRASH FATAL TO NORTH DAKOTAN

Grand Forks, N. D., Sept. 5.—In an automobile accident four miles west of Forest River yesterday afternoon, Charles H. Service, a chauffeur, was instantly killed and his employer, George E. Towle, investment manager of Northwestern National Life Insurance company of Minneapolis, was bruised but not seriously injured.

Mr. Towle's home is at Park River and has been visiting friends at Forest River. He had started for home, Mr. Service driving the car. About four miles out of town the steering gear broke while the machine was going down grade. The car ran into the ditch, and Mr. Towle was thrown over a wire fence. Mr. Service was thrown into the fence with the machine on top of him, and was crushed to death.

Service was about 45 years of age and a resident of Park River. He is survived by his second wife, to whom he was married a year ago, and seven small children.





