City News LAYMEN CAN HELP IN MISSION WORK

CLERGY DISCUSS GROWING INTEREST IN SPREADING GOSPEL.

Missionary Convention Takes Up Phases of Special Efforts Made to Increase Knowledge of Religious Affairs—Laymen May Be Organized to Push the Work—The Program.

(Early convention news on page 5.) Three addresses by men who have engaged actively in missionary work were the features of this morning's sessions of the conference of the sixth missionary department.

The second speaker was Rev. Rufus W. Clark, D.D., department secretary, who discussed "The Laymen's Forward Movement." Dr. Clark asked for the cooperation of the ministers throughout the country in the movement which is without an organization.

Delegates to the conference lunched together in the Gethsemane parish house and the afternoon session began at 2 o'clock. Rt. Rev. Edward R. Atwill, bishop of Kansas City, presided and three addresses were delivered.


