#### TRAFFIC MEN SEE INDICTMENT PERIL

RECESS OF GRAND JURY LENGTHENS SUSPENSE.

Old Federal Injunction Hangs Over Heads of Five Southwestern Roads, and Others Now Fear That Uncle Sam's Hand Will Slap Them Good and Hard.

Worry and apprehension on the part of railroad men and shippers has not been lessened any by the fact that the special grand jury is taking a vacation of one week. The suspense is wearisome on a good many of them, and this is not relieved by the general impression that the jury will take more and possibly new evidence when its members reconvene.

Traffic men who have been figuring on the possibilities of indictments resulting from the jury investigations recall the fact that at the time the Elkins law was put into effect, an injunction against any violation of the law was issued by the federal court against five of the ten lines running into Minneapolis. These were the southwestern lines, or the Milwaukee, North Western, Rock Island, Great Western and the Burlington. In violating the law either line would incur the danger of a penalty for contempt of court as well as for the actual violation of the law, in case of conviction for the offense.

They have called attention to the fact that four of the lines not specifically named in the injunction have been concerned directly by the examination which the special federal grand jury has been conducting. These are the St. Louis, Wisconsin Central, Great Northern and Chicago and North Western. The Soo and the Northern Pacific, the other two lines not enjoined, have not been represented by witnesses to date, so far as can be learned.

#### WOUND REDEEMS GOWARD

"NORTHERN LIGHTS," IN WHICH JOURNAL CADETS APPEAR AT LYCEUM, TURNS ON A LITTLE-NOTED FACT IN SURGICAL SCIENCE.

"Had anyone asked Mary Queen of Scots why her son, James I., shuddered at the sight of a drawn sword, she would have answered, 'Darling, this is the way in which the physical cowardice of Wallace Gray, the son of a veteran and gallant soldier, is explained by Swiftwind, one of the characters in 'Northern Lights,' which is running at the Lyceum this week. The character of Wallace Gray is a fascinating study of the effect of prenatal influence upon character. Born of fighting stock and destined for the army, Gray proves to be a contemptible coward in his first battle. At last, desperate, he re-enlists in the army, hoping that he may be shot in action before he has time to run. He is shot while running away from his first action, but the wound in his hand is not fatal. He falls into the hands of his father and the regiment, is sentenced to the punishment of a coward and deserter. While waiting trial, he is under the care of the post surgeon, an educated Sioux named John Swiftwind."

By a strange chance, young Gray gets an opportunity to redeem himself and does so by conspicuous gallantry. For Swiftwind, aware of the fact that Gray's father was wounded just before the birth of his son, suspects a nervous defect makes the young man fear the sound of firearms. Swiftwind performs a delicate operation on his spine, which relieves the pressure there and restores his courage.

Leoncavallo Recalls Effect of His First Triumph.

It is not often that Minneapolis has an opportunity to hear a world-famous composer conduct an orchestra in his own compositions and the appearance of Leoncavallo will be a musical event. The program includes the favorite "I Pagliacci," the Italian masterpiece, as well as selections from his other operas, "La Boheme," "Zaza," and the march "America," which was dedicated to President Roosevelt.

When "I Pagliacci" was given, the composer and his young wife were too poor to buy even a seat downstairs in the Scala theater in Milan and in an obscure corner of the balcony they waited tremblingly for the verdict of the audience. "When the great Bariton had ended the prolog," recalls the composer, "and the public shouted, 'Bravo,' 'bravissimo,' and the applause echoed from one corner of the theater to the other, I felt I was going to faint. My wife could no longer restrain herself, she threw her arms around me and I said repeatedly, crying, 'You win, Ruggiero,' 'you win. I told you, you would!'"


