TARGET PRACTICE MAIN OBJECT OF MILITIA CAMP

Three Virginia Regiments Will Devote Their Efforts to Teaching Men How to Shoot.

WILL GO TO VIRGINIA BEACH

Many Improvements in Volunteer Army of Virginia Have Been Initiated by Adjutant-General Sale. Rifle Range Now Fully Equipped.

During the encampments of the three regiments of Virginia infantry at the State Rifle Range, Virginia Beach, this summer, strenuous efforts will be made to teach the volunteer soldiers to shoot.

At Virginia Beach the infantrymen will be started shooting at a range of 200 yards, the distance being increased to 600 yards and finally to 1,000 yards.
