

YOU HAVE TO RAISE COST LIMIT OF SCOUT CRUISERS

Plans for Vessels Opened, With Result That Only One Firm Offers Direct Proposal.

UNTIL CONGRESS MEETS

Companies Submit Proposals, Based on Sliding Scale Arrangement, Which Would Take Variations of Prices Into Consideration.

WASHINGTON, November 1.—Authority from Congress to raise the cost may have to be sought by the Department before it can award contracts for construction of the four five-knot scout cruisers in the building program. Bids for the vessels were opened to-day with the understanding that one builder, the Seattle Construction and Dry Dock Company, offered a direct proposal. This company bids the limit of \$5,000,000 for the machinery, but it proposed to build only one boat.


