## WHOOPIING COUGH IS RAGING IN SALT LAKE

An epidemic of whooping cough is raging among the children of Salt Lake, and a number of adults are said to have been included in the list of victims of the contagion. Numerous cases have been reported to the Health department within the past week.

At the home of J. H. Raleigh, 34 North First West street, three children are stricken with the disease. It is said to have been contracted from association with other children who were affected. In other cases all the children in the family have been stricken.

Physicians declare that the disease is widespread and has victims in every part of the city. Where a case is discovered the child is at once prohibited from attending school and the home is quarantined.

In the case of adults, however, few restrictions are observed, and they are not detained from their duties by the Health officials.

"There are a great many cases in the city," said Dr. E. E. Wilcox yesterday. "It is the usual epidemic that takes possession of a community every two or three years. I have a number of cases myself and other physicians have told me of numerous others. Except in the case of very young children the disease is rarely fatal. I have heard of no fatalities as yet."

## RAIN THAT MEANS GOLD FOR FARMERS

Heavy Showers in Southern California Save Fruit and Grain Growers From Heavy Losses.

SAN FRANCISCO, Feb. 16.—During the last two days rain has fell copiously over southern California, relieving the apprehensions of farmers and fruitgrowers that their crops this season would not prove profitable. The storm has extended as far south as San Diego, where it is still raining, with prospects of continuance. About two inches of rain fell in Los Angeles. The downpour was heavy from Fort Conception north and in the great California valleys.

One marked effect of the storm will be a rapid rise in the rivers of the State, and warnings to this effect have been given out. The storm has been accompanied by heavy gales at sea, but no damage to shipping has been reported. The rain will be of inestimable value to California.

## PULL DOWN THE FLAG.

A CITIZEN WHO THINKS THERE SHOULD BE AN END EVEN TO WHOOPING-COUGH.

It is a sign of warning to have a big yellow flag posted upon the front of the house, and visitors usually give wide berth to a house so marked. It is, however, considered a necessary precautionary measure to quarantine houses where contagious diseases have manifested themselves, but there is no need, according to the following letter, to leave the yellow rag up for eternity.

"The Board of Health—Gentlemen—I hereby respectfully request that the sign, 'Whooping Cough,' be removed from my house, or that you may permit the same to be removed.

"It is over two months since any of our children got the disease, so any further danger of contagion is not to be feared. We have put up with the inconvenience of having the sign up until now, but do consider it damaging to us to have it there any longer. Please attend to this at once. Respectfully,
