Special Stocks Were the Factors

Usual Market Leaders Were Sluggish and Neglected in Wall Street.

NEW YORK, June 1.—There was a slightly wider movement of prices in today's stock market than the recent average, but this was largely confined to special stocks of the dormant class. The usual market leaders were sluggish and neglected, and their fluctuations cannot be accepted as indicative of any widely-held opinions on the market.

A number of the Southwestern railroad stocks advanced, but the advance was largely confined to the railroad group under leadership. The selling of special stocks for the last few days is attributed by the sellers to fears that the change of the speculative party have largely reduced and supporting mechanism of the market.

There were sales at a decline of 3 1/2 points of Detroit Southern, the June coupon on which it is proposed to fund, and the same amount of the Ohio division is, on which the interest does not fall on until September, 10 1/2 points.
