

WRONG NAME WILL NOT QUASH SUIT

Rule Laid Down by the Supreme Court. Plea in Abatement Must Be Filed to Take Advantage of Error.

Judgment of Lower Court Affirmed, Finding Albert La Chall and John Barry Guilty of Robbery.

When a defendant is sued by a wrong name he must file a plea in abatement if it is desired to take advantage of the error.

That it was and is a non-resident of the State of Illinois, and that it never was duly or regularly cited to appear.

Another opinion was handed down from the chambers yesterday, affirming the judgment of the lower court in the case of the State of Utah vs. Albert La Chall and John Barry.

No Technicality Avoided. The Supreme court holds that the servant of force or intimidation implies that the property was taken against the will of the person robbed.
