NEWS NOTES BY WIRE.

NEW YORK, Aug. 8.—The most extensive jewelry robbery ever perpetrated in this country, involving a loss of \$200,000, is engaging the attention of the police and scores of private detectives in Eastern cities.

NEW YORK, Aug. 8.—Records of the Board of Health and of Bellevue hospital indicate that this city is having the healthiest summer season in ten years.

ST. LOUIS, Mo., Aug. 8.—The fifth annual meeting of the International Typographical union of North America, with representatives of 70 subordinate and affiliated bodies present from various parts of the United States and Canada, met today and will continue in session during the week.

LONDON, Aug. 8.—In the House of Commons today Premier Balfour, replying to a question on the subject, said the British Government adheres to its conviction that there was no adequate justification for the sinking of the British steamer, the Kaigaiti, Commander by the Vladivostok squadron.

ST. PETERSBURG, Aug. 8.—Gen. Sakharoff reports that up to noon yesterday there had been no change in the Manchurian army's sphere of operations.

BERLIN, Aug. 8.—The Tageblatt this morning prints the following dispatch from Liao Yang, dated today: "The western Russian forces north of Halaingang suffer a heavy attack today. Many wounded Russians are here."


ST. PETERSBURG, Aug. 8.—The report that the Japanese are landing troops in Lousia bay, about nine miles north-west of Port Arthur, evokes no surprise at the War office. The officials there are astonished that the Japanese had neglected to do so at the outset of the siege of Port Arthur.

ST. PETERSBURG, Aug. 8.—An important conference on the military situation was held at the Peterhof palace today.

PHILLIPSBURG, Mont., Aug. 8.—John Christie, the partner of George F. Hammond in the robbery of the North Coast Limited train near Bearmouth, was arraigned before Justice of the Peace Connolly this morning and pleaded guilty. He was committed under \$5,000 bonds.

SAN FRANCISCO, Aug. 8.—Maj. Gen. MacArthur left today for Camp Atascadero in San Luis Obispo county where the army maneuvers will take place, beginning next Sunday. Gen. MacArthur will be commander-in-chief of the mobilization and the entire force.

VLADIVOSTOK, Aug. 8.—The British steamer Calchas, from Tacoma for Japan ports, which was arrested by the Vladivostok squadron thirty miles north of Tsiklo bay during the recent cruise of the Pacific coast of Japan, arrived here today in charge of a prize crew.


