

BINGHAM RALLY HIGH OLD TIME Few Attended Until the Dance Began.

Festive Young Folks Kept Their Feet in Tune With the Speeches.

Lots of Fun, and Almost a Riot, but No Votes Captured for the Smootier Ticket.

Special to The Tribune. BINGHAM, Oct. 15.—The Republican rally at Bingham Friday night was anything but a frost-free night was red hot. Members of the party who had been telling that the overflowing American meeting of the evening previous was a failure, and that the great speech of Judge Hiles fell flat, were pleased to note, when Charley Brink called the rally to order, that about half the seats were empty. But it had been announced that a dance would wind up the festivities, and at about 10:30, when well-constituted rallies are supposed to disperse, the hall was well filled with young people who wanted to swing their partners.

Programme at the Rally.

The programme as rendered was about this way: First part—Vaudeville. Director, Charles Brink. Grand overture, Bingham orchestra. Lick and Jill, imitations of the imitatable. "Chinese" imitator, Josh Davis; campaign song and encore, quartette; Bats in the Belfry. "Am Thy Father's Son" (variations), Harry Joseph. While the only Harry who charmed the audience, Wun Lung passed candles around among the ladies; also a treat from Harry, that was toothsome to all.

Second part—Interlude. Selection, Bingham orchestra. "Soreheads, Cranks, Pecks and Grooving Pictures" and topographic view of the American party; Judge Bowman, Chink look, Wun Lung, circus and hippodrome impressions, figures, imprecations, statistics, imprecations, damn, damn, damn! Fliz! Judge Reed. Everybody danced!

Caused Great Laughter.

There were no files on the Bingham orchestra. The quartette club was excellent. Wun Lung's antics caused great laughter among the small boys. Mr. Kinney started out for a presentation of heavy national topics, but, having put up the frame, left it to abuse Senator Kearns, Frank Cannon, Judge Hiles and the American party. The poetry of the saying that there were others, sat down.

Denounced American Party.

The great event of the evening, barring the dance, was Judge Reed's denunciation of the American party. By 10:20 the hall was filled by young folks who had come struggling in and wanted to demonstrate "the poetry of motion." Possibly Mr. Reed thought they had come to hear his speech. Anyway, although it was a matter of statistics and was full of a bicycle tire of denunciations of the new party movement and its leaders. He turned loose a tirade that was like an endless chain. The audience took it good-naturedly for half an hour and then began to keep time with their feet to the speaker's sentiments.


