INDIANAPOLIS, Dec. 13.—In connection with the reopening of the suit for \$2,000,000 brought by the State through Attorney-General Ketchum against the Vandalia railroad, Mr. Ketchum filed an application for a receiver of the road and asked for an injunction to prohibit the proposed merger of the Terre Haute & Indianapolis, St. Louis, Vandalia & Terre Haute, Indianapolis & Vincennes, Logansport & Toledo, and Terre Haute & Canadiana Northern companies, all of which are at present controlled by the Pennsylvania system.

Morgan to Invade Canada.

VANCOUVER, B. C., Dec. 13.—A confident report of J. P. Morgan has just been received that he will make arrangements for the extension of the line to the Pacific coast at the earliest opportunity.

The wedding day was set and the place, the parsonage of the Baptist church, Rev. John R. Flizer's services were secured for the occasion, and the hour was 7 p. m.

The groom-elect, ignorant of the fact that Mrs. Taylor had interfered, came to town in a carriage drawn by a pair of fine horses to claim his bride.

SCARE IN CHICAGO.

Lights Went Out and Thousands of Shoppers Were Left in Dark.

CHICAGO, Dec. 13.—Thousands of shoppers in the big downtown department stores have had a scare when the electric lights suddenly went out, leaving the interior of the buildings in darkness.

An accident in the power-house of an electric light company was the cause of the trouble. Business was partially paralyzed in the affected territory for nearly an hour.

The trouble, arising in seriousness, extended over practically the entire territory from North avenue to Twelfth street, and from the river to the lake.
